Addendum to RFQ information for Live Stream Services. Questions + Answers, shared with all potential offerors:

- Q1) In the pricing grid, it notes 3-4 cameras to service two venues. Are these 2 stages streaming simultaneously or will it be one venue or the other?
 - A) It will be one venue or the other. The venues will not stream simultaneously. But the turnaround time between events may be very short. So it is up to each vendor individually if you need one set of cameras that could move between venues (within just a few minutes) or if you would need two sets of cameras. A "set" of cameras should be 3-4, to capture wide, tight, and ASL shots.
- Q2) Should we list our installation and removal crew as a separate item or bundle with the rental cost of equipment?
 - A) You may list it as a separate line item if that is helpful, but please make it clear it goes hand in hand with the equipment.
- Q3) What central space is provided for control, switching and streaming?
 - A) The festival can provide a back-of-house tent-covered space. Some vendors have in the past expressed preference to bring in a video trailer of some kind, so we ask that you list that cost if that is a requirement for you to do the work.
- Q4.1) As we were going through the livestream package excel sheet, I wanted to clarify the trailer/tent section in it. We were wondering essentially if the section is asking for how much it would cost to rent a trailer or tent from the festival.
 - A) If you need under-tent working space, to build out your "video village," the Festival can provide that, you do not need to rent it.

However, if you require a specialty video trailer of some kind to complete your work in, you would need to rent or provide that independently. We could collaboratively work with you to find a place to park it on the Festival site.

The festival does have limited office trailer space on the festival site for festival staff to work in. There will be jump stations where you can stop in to use your laptop, get a breath of air conditioning, or leave equipment charging overnight, or lock things up overnight. But it would not be sufficient space to build out a "video village" or command center.

- Q4.2) Will the trailer be provided to us by the festival or are we renting the trailer and providing you with the amount it cost us to rent the trailer?
 - A) A dedicated trailer would not be provided by the Festival. But if you choose to rent your own trailer and would include that in the cost for your service, let us know in your quote. We acknowledge some vendors have a more minimalist set up and would choose to not have a trailer on site thus not incurring that cost. The Festival will provide a sufficient outdoor space for you to work from, under a tent, with access to power, likely near the audio team so you can receive the house mix feed.
